8 Civil motions under Civil L.R. 7-2 in cases assigned to Magistrate Judge Lloyd may be
9 noticed for hearing on any Tuesday at 10:00 a.m.

10 Civil motions under Civil L.R. 7-2 in cases assigned to Magistrate Judge Cousins may be
11 noticed for hearing on any Wednesdays at 1:00 p.m.

12 Pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 16 and 26 and Civil L.R. 16-10(a), a Case Management Conference
13 will be held on _____ at _____, at the United States
14 Courthouse, 280 South First Street, San Jose, California. This conference may be continued only by
15 court order pursuant to Civil L.R. 16-2(e). Parties may not stipulate to continue a Case Management
16 Conference without court approval.

17 Pursuant to Civil L.R. 16-3, in advance of the Case Management Conference, counsel shall
18 confer with their respective clients and opposing counsel for the purposes specified in Fed.R.Civ.P.
19 26(f), Civil L.R. 16-8 and 16-9, and in patent cases, Patent L.R. 3-1 through 3-6. A meaningful meet
20 and confer process prior to the Case Management Conference and good faith compliance with the
21 requirements of this Order are essential elements of effective case management. Failure to meet and
22 confer, to be prepared for the Case Management Conference or to file a Joint Case Management
23 Conference Statement may result in sanctions. Parties may, but are not required, to attend the Case
24 Management Conference.

25 In all "E-filing" cases when filing papers in connection with any motion for determination by
26 a judge, the parties shall, in addition to filing papers electronically, lodge with chambers a printed
27 copy of the papers by the close of the next court day following the day the papers are filed

1 electronically. These printed copies shall be marked "Chambers Copy" and shall be submitted to the
2 Clerk's Office, in an envelope clearly marked with the Judge's name, case number and "E-filing
3 Chambers Copy." Parties shall not file a paper copy of any document with the Clerk's Office that
4 has already been filed electronically.


